Tournament Organisation and Procedures

- Rotorua Boys' High School will host the annual formal tournament dinner on site in the Raukura Lounge (Millennium Centre) at 6:15 PM on Sunday, August 4th. Team vans can park on school grounds accessible via the Pukuatua St main school entry.
- The Managers' meeting will be held on Sunday, August 4th, starting at 6:45 PM in the Putaiao Centre collaboration space.
- A signed copy of the registration form, completed with the Principal's signature, is required at this meeting for any changes to those already submitted.
- The tournament will be run using Hockey NZ Rules.
- All games will be played on the two Smallbone Park Hockey turfs. Turf 1 is closest to the large car park, and Turf 2 is closest to the Pavilion.
- All games commence at 8.30am on Monday and 8.00am on Tuesday. On Wednesday, the first game commences at 8:00am.
- Each team will have access to changing rooms. Turf 1 rooms are the portacom style changing rooms near the turf, and Turf 2 rooms are in the Rotorua Hockey Pavilion.
- Toilets are located in the main Pavilion.
- The first named team must supply the match ball.
- Alternate strips between schools with similar colors will be decided at the Manager's meeting.
- Umpires will be provided for each game. Team umpires can report to Neil Watson upstairs in the Pavilion for information and a place to reside between games.
- A results sheet will be posted in the dugouts at both venues each morning. The tournament convenor will email a results sheet of the day's play to all managers each evening.
- At the end of Pool Play, if teams are tied on equal points, goals for and against will be used against only the teams that are tied in their pool to determine final placings, as per HNZ rules. Semi-finals and final placing games will be decided by shootout in the case of a tie.
- Ice will be available each day from the dugout.
- A short prize-giving will take place at the conclusion of the final, where certificates and the Super 8 Shield will be presented to the winning school. An MVP will be determined for each team following the final game and communicated to Neil Watson or Bruce Buckton.
