# **Tournament Rules**

### Section Play

- 1. Games will consist of 2 x 35 minute halves
- 2. Points will be awarded as follows:
  - 3 points for a win
  - 1 point for a draw
  - 0 points for a loss
- 3. Section placing will be decided as follows:
  - 1. Points gained
  - 2. Goal difference
  - 3. Most goals scored
  - 4. Penalty kicks taken under FIFA rules this would take place as soon as possible after pool play ends on Wednesday morning.

### **Post Section Play**

All games, except the final, will consist of 2 x 35 minute halves. If there is a draw at full time, the winner will be decided by penalty kicks taken under FIFA rules.

The final will be 2 x 40 minute halves. If there is a draw at full time, 10 minutes each way of extra time will be played. If there is a draw at full time the winner will be decided by penalty kicks taken under FIFA rules.

### Substitutions

Up to five substitutes may be used in a game. The rules for substituting players will be the same as under the rules for the substitution of three players.

#### Cautions and Ordering Off

- 3 cautions no play for next game
- 1 ordering off no play for next game
- 2 orderings off no play for rest of tournament

#### Team Colours

The team named first on the draw has the first choice of which team strip it will wear, but it is expected that team managers will support each other with this issue throughout the tournament.

#### Team Cards

Team managers – please hand in team cards to the Tournament Controller in the Clubrooms at Neil Hunt Park, please make sure that they are signed by the opposition manager and referee ASAP after each match.


